Lesson Title:

Phonemic Awareness (isolation) – Missing beginning, middle and end sounds. Blending.

Objective:

To pick out each phoneme in simple VC and CVC (two and three sound) words. To blend sounds together to form a word.

Activities:

- Canadian Phonics 1 App: Exercises 5, 6, 7
Teacher can demo on interactive whiteboard or in small groups.
- iPads off. Teacher to choose a few simple CVC words and see if the class can work out all the sounds in the words. Examples: 'cat', 'dog', 'pup', 'fig'. Note that this is still an oral activity with no letters used. As students work out the sounds, represent the sounds with a square or magnetic marker on a whiteboard.
- iPads off. Blending practice. I'm thinking of a word that is made up of the sounds, /t/, /i/, /p/. What is the word?
