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## **Lesson Title:**

Phonics – more letter/sound relationships, words, simple sentences.

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## **Objective:**

Phonics – more letter/sound relationships, words, simple sentences.

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## **Activities:**

1. Canadian Phonics 1 App – Exercise 9, 11 and 12.
  - Note that these exercises can be used to both learn and test phonics knowledge - the correct answer flashes if not selected after a certain time.
  - Teacher can demo these exercises in small groups, or by plugging the iPad into an interactive whiteboard.
2. Canadian Phonics worksheets: using the letter/sound relationships the students have been learning, they can now try reading (decoding) some words. Print out some of the Canadian Phonics worksheets, 1 to 8. If required, students can use the Canadian

Phonics 1 app exercise 10, to help decode these written words by tapping on the letters. The real task is to blend those sounds together into a word. This activity is best done initially in a small group with teacher assistance.

3. Canadian Phonics worksheets 9 -12. All these simple sentences are fully decodable using the sound/letter relationships the students have been learning. Where appropriate, students can draw a picture to match the sentence, or rewrite the sentence to practice handwriting.
  - Revise worksheets to check students understand meaning.
4. This lesson can be revisited repeatedly until students get a good knowledge of these sound/letter relationships, and how to blend sounds to make words.
